# Say Hello

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## **Farm Animal Faces**

### You will need:

- The template
- · pop sticks or cardboard stripes
- · crayons or pencils
- · sticky tape.

#### What to do:

- 1. Colour in template optional. Name the colours and describe the animals.
- 2. Cut out faces for the child but talk about the process of cutting and model the technique.
- 3. Stick faces to pop sticks. You can cut pieces of tape, or hold for the child.

#### Ideas

Use the puppet faces in lots of different ways:

- Hold a farmyard disco and dance to music
- Ask each other questions to guess the animals
- Have the animals talk to each other with different noises like in the story
- Help the child to identify what noises go with what animal
- Role play being on a farm and the animals making friends with each other
- Hide an animal mask and play hide and seek
- Suggest the child take the lead and make up their own game.
